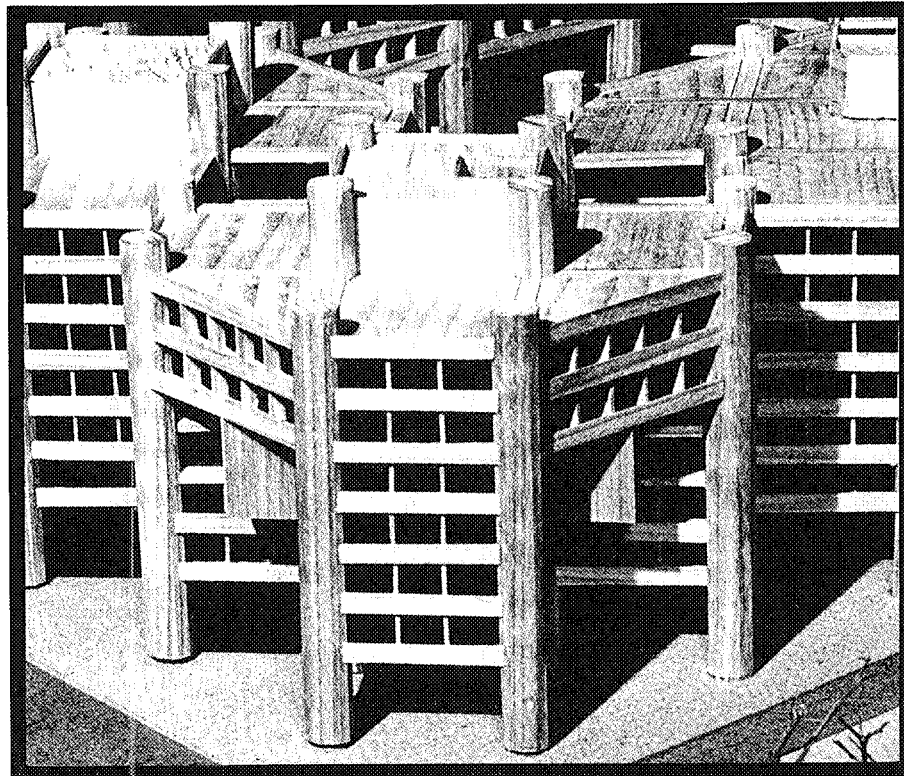


BIOGRAPHY & BIBLIOGRAPHY



1934 Born in Hoshiarpur, Punjab, India.

1939-1951 Lived in Delhi and Simla and attended Harcourt Butler Higher Secondary School.

1951-1954 Attended Delhi School of Architecture, New Delhi.



1955-1961 Moved to London. Attended the Architectural Association School of Architecture for one year. Completed formal professional training at the Brixton School of Building, London. Worked as an architectural assistant in various practices in London and as a theatre scenery designer in the evenings. Became an Associate of the Royal Institute of British Architects, London.

1961-1962 Worked in the offices of Michel Ecochard, architect, Paris. Married H  l  ne in 1962.

1962 Returned to New Delhi to set up his own architectural practice.

1963-1972 Taught at the Delhi School of Architecture.

1974 Opened a second office in Tehran, Iran.

1985 Founded the Architectural Research Cell with Ram Sharma.

1986 Curator of the exhibition 'Traditional Architecture in India' for the Festival of India in Paris.

1989 Recipient of Sir Robert Matthew Award from the Commonwealth Association of Architects, London. Awarded Gold Medal by the Indian Institute of Architects.
